//// 4. ENTRANTS ////

Entries from a maximum of 10 teams will be accepted for the Championships, with 5 drivers in each team.
All drivers must be aged 14 years or older. Teams may be all male, all female or mixed male and female.

//// 5. ENTRY FEES ////

Entry fees are Baht 6,000 per team. Entry fees include the racing sessions and BBQ buffet for team members only.

//// 6. THE COMPETITION ////

The format of the competition is as follows:

- 6.1 Qualifying Races – First session: there will be five qualifying races with one member of each team in each of the five races.
Each qualifying race will consist of 3 practice laps and 5 timed laps
- 6.2 Qualifying Races – Second Session: there will be a further five qualifying races with one member of each team in each of the five races.
Each race will consist of 3 practice laps and 5 timed lap
- 6.3 Qualifying Races - Third Session (repeat of previous sessions)
- 6.4 Championship Final – the fastest 10 ten drivers from the 3 qualifying sessions will compete in the Championship Final.
The Final will be 1 race consisting of 3 practice laps and 5 racing laps
There will therefore be a total of 16 races and every driver of every team will compete in a minimum of 3 races.

//// 7. RESULTS ////

- 7.1 All go karts are fitted with a transponder relaying lap times to the computerised timing system at Phuket Racing Go Kart Co. Ltd.
- 7.2 Drivers will draw for selection of karts to drive in each race
- 7.3 Results for the Final will be determined by finishing order in the race.
- 7.4 Team Results will be lowest aggregate of the fastest individual lap time of the four fastest drivers in each team.

//// 8. AWARDS ////

Only members of the 'amateur' teams are eligible for the following awards

8.1 Team Winners	Trophy, medals and certificates
8.2 Teams 2nd & 3rd	Certificates
8.3 Individual Winner	Trophy, medal and certificate
8.4 Plate Winner	Medal & certificate
8.5 Best All Ladies Team	Medals & Certificates

There will also be a separate award for the fastest 'professional' driver from Phuket Go-Karts Racing Co. Ltd.
